MINUTES

OF THE

SHAKOPEE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION (Regular Meeting)

President Amundson called the regular session of the Shakopee Public Utilities Commission to order at the Shakopee Public Utilities meeting room at 5:00 P.M., December 18, 2017.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Commissioners Joos, Amundson, Hennen and Weyer. Also present, Liaison Mocol, Utilities Manager Crooks, Finance Director Schmid, Planning & Engineering Director Adams, Line Superintendent Drent, Water Superintendent Schemel and Marketing/Customer Relations Director Walsh.

Motion by Joos, seconded by Weyer to approve the minutes of the December 4, 2017 Commission meeting. Motion carried.

There were no Communication items.

President Amundson offered the agenda for approval.

Motion by Weyer seconded by Hennen to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried.

Motion by Weyer, seconded by Hennen to approve the Consent Business agenda as presented. Motion carried.

Utilities Manager Crooks reviewed the 2017 SPU donations made to community organizations.

Marketing/Customer Relations Director Walsh reviewed the front counter redesign. This is being planned to accommodate a third Customer Service Representative, increase privacy for customers and address security issues with the present design for the counter.

Mr. Schemel advised the Commission that agenda packets will be available to the general public via the SPU website beginning in 2018.

Mr. Crooks provided an update with the E-Billing project and will provide a detailed implementation schedule for the remaining portion of the project beginning in March 2018.

Item 11e: November 2017 Financial Results was received under Consent Business.

The designation of MMPA Alternate Representative was discussed by Mr. Crooks. Past Commissioner Helkamp had served in that capacity. The appointment will be made at a future Commission meeting.

The Board of Directors of the Minnesota Municipal Power Agency (MMPA) met on December 19, 2017 at the offices of Shakopee Public Utilities in Shakopee, Minnesota.

Participation in MMPA's Residential Clean Energy Choice program increased 9%, with more than 100 new customers signing up for the program. Customer penetration of MMPA's Clean Energy Choice program for residential customers increased to 2.5%, with a range of market penetration by members of 1.2% to 5.5%.

The Board approved MMPA's budget and rates for 2018. The budgeted average rate to members for 2018 is \$75.15 MWh, a 1.1% increase over the 2017 budget.

The Board discussed the status of the renewable projects that the Agency is pursuing. The Buffalo Solar project is nearing completion.

The Board elected the following officers for 2018: John Crooks – Chair, Matt Podhradsky – Vice Chair, Brian Frandle – Secretary and Troy Adams – Treasurer.

ISSUE -

The Shakopee Public Utilities Commission should appoint an interim Alternate Representative to the MMPA Board.

BACKGROUND -

Our wholesale power provider, Minnesota Municipal Power Agency (MMPA), is governed by a Board of Directors. The Board consists of voting members, referred to as Representatives and non-voting members, referred to as Alternates. These members are made up of both technical staff and policy makers from each member Utility. Each member Utility is allowed one Representative and one Alternate.

DISCUSSION -

Presently, the Utilities Manager is appointed as the SPU Representative. Commissioner Helkamp was appointed as our Alternate. Therefore the Alternate position has been open since early November. Even as the Utilities Manager also currently serves as the Chair of the MMPA Board, it is important to have a person assigned as Alternate.

The reasons for the Alternate is two-fold. The first being this person attends the monthly Board meetings and is therefore up-to-date on the issues and information before the MMPA Board. This provides the opportunity to have two points of view concerning the issues. The second reason is more obvious; to be present when the Utilities Manager is unable to attend.

REQUEST -

To make an interim appointment to the MMPA Board of Directors as the SPU Alternate. This would be an interim position until the first Commission meeting in April.

We are prepared to officially launch the 2018 Residential Clean Energy Choice program.

The previous Eco Energy program was closed and removed from all customer accounts effective 12/31/17.

In November, a letter was sent to all Eco Energy customers informing them of this action and information about the Clean Energy Choice (CEC) replacement program was shared. The customers had three options available to them: they could elect to not enroll in CEC; they could enroll at one of three levels of their choice, or they could take no action and we would automatically enroll them at 100% for \$3 additional each month.

January 10th was the cut-off for enrollment in January. Enrollment or cancellation requests will need to be received by the 10th of each month to make that month's billing. If it is received after the 10th, the addition/deletion will occur with the next month's billing.

After working with the enrollment database and ensuring we have all customers, new and converted Eco Energy customers, the breakdown of the inaugural Clean Energy Choice customers is as follows:

188 people enrolled at 100%

12 people enrolled at 75%

25 people enrolled at 50%

Continued promotion of the CEC program includes two more months of imprinted billing envelopes, a second bill stuffer mailing, a PSA ad or article in the SVN, as well as office staff wearing "Ask Me About Clean Energy Choice" t-shirts at the service center on Fridays.



Sep 28, 2017 - Jan 9, 2018: Sessions via Social Referral




