



Project Engineer

Shakopee Public Utilities has an opportunity in the Planning/Engineering Department for a Project Engineer. This position is responsible for providing engineering, design, and project management for the electric and water systems. Specific responsibilities include:

- Reviewing engineering specifications, sketches, and supporting documents; overseeing or drafting plans and maps using computer-aided and manual drafting methods; preparing engineering documents; confirming adherence to utility specifications and safety standards, and discussing component design with the planning/engineering director, water and electric superintendents.
- Managing system construction projects and related activities including project estimates, permitting, scheduling, liaisons with developer, engineers and contractors, and contract administration.
- Review project work of engineering technicians and ensure system mapping is assigned and completed
- Ensure completion of work orders and maintain electrical system project documentation filing
- Requires a degree in electrical engineering with three years of experience and a valid State of Minnesota Professional Engineering license or Engineering in Training Certification. Valid Minnesota driver's license required.
