Many markets have been affected by rising costs and the utility industry is no exception. Increased purchased power costs, widespread material shortages and higher input costs have resulted in SPU electric and water billing changes for 2022.

- Electric service fees will increase slightly (ex: \$0.50/month for residential customers)
- Water service fees and usage rates will increase by 5% (which is 11¢-15¢/1,000 gallons, depending on rate classification)
- Demand charges for non-residential customers will increase by \$0.20/kW
- Base kWh energy charges will include a larger portion of the power cost adjustment (PCA) charge to help moderate higher wholesale power costs, especially in the summer months.
- SPU monthly utility bills will remain very competitive with collective billing charges lower than most neighboring utilities.

The new changes will be effective with your January 2022 billing statement.

Beginning January 1, 2022, sanitary sewer and storm drainage utility rates are changing and will be reflected on monthly utility bills.

Residential property owners will see a small increase in their bills. For the typical home utilizing 6,000 gallons of water per month, the increase will amount to about \$1.50 per month.

These rate changes include the following:



An increase of 20 cents per 1,000 gallons to the Metropolitan Council's monthly sanitary sewer rate.



An increase of 3 cents per 1,000 gallons to the monthly city sewer rate.



An increase of 10 cents to the monthly city sewer flat fee.



An increase of 3 cents to the monthly city storm drainage fee for a residential home.
