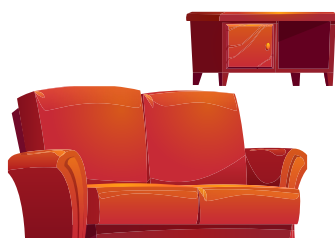
STOP 1 ELECTRONICS RECYCLING

Car batteries, tires, stereo, TV, VCR/DVD, desktop copier/printer/scanner, cellphones, answering machines, laptops, vacuums, small household electronics, console or projection TV, computers (clean personal info off hard drives before recycling), lead-acid automotive batteries, (maximum 8)



STOP 2 FURNITURE RECYCLING

Light bulbs (first 10 free; \$2 per bulb over 10)
Couches, chairs, miscellaneous furniture.



STOP 3 GARBAGE TRUCKS

Household garbage: Plastic, mirrors/glass, broken/old household items, trash, etc.

Please put your loose garbage in a box or tote bin for easy unloading.



STOP 4 METAL RECYCLING

Propane tanks, general scrap metal, BBQ grills (remove briquettes), lawn mowers (drain fuel/oil), patio furniture, motors, pots and pans, copper piping/tubing, brass faucets, stainless sinks, fitness equipment, bed frames, etc.

STOP 5 YARD WASTE RECYCLING

Grass, leaves, garden material, brush, etc. In compostable bags only. Brush bundles cut in 6-foot lengths bound with biodegradable twine.

STOP 6 CONSTRUCTION RECYCLING

Concrete/asphalt, landscape blocks, untreated lumber. Residential only.



STOP 7 MATTRESS RECYCLING

Mattresses/box spring (\$25 each).



STOP 8 APPLIANCE RECYCLING

Appliances (\$15 each): Stove, refrigerator, freezer, water heater, humidifiers, window air conditioner, water softener, dishwasher, microwave, washer, dryer, etc.



ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED

Clothing, liquids, chemicals, oils, paints, tree stumps, dirt, RV/gas refrigerators, contractor building material debris, hot tubs, bath tubs, whirlpool tubs, lithium-ion batteries, household alkaline batteries.
