STANDARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS TO RECEIVE MUNICIPAL WATER SERVICE

- 1. The developer/customer must make a written request for service that identifies the property in question along with the name, telephone number, and address of a contact.
- 2. The developer/customer shall submit for approval construction plans for a water main distribution system designed in accordance with the Water main Design Criteria adopted by the Utilities Commission. The developer/customer shall include the engineer's estimate of the installed water main cost.
- 3. The developer/customer shall install the water main distribution system as approved by the General Manager.
- 4. The developer/customer shall pay all Shakopee Public Utilities associated water main plan review and construction inspection costs. The developer/customer shall pay a cash deposit, prior to plan approval, equal to <u>8.5%</u> of the engineer's estimate of the installed watermain cost.
- 5. The developer/customer shall pay a Trunk Water Charge, prior to plan approval, in accordance with the Trunk Water Policy adopted by the Utilities Commission. The current rate is equal to \$5,359.00 per net acre, and is subject to change without notice.
- 6. The Utilities Commission will pay any oversizing costs per standard policy. The developer/customer shall submit a cost estimate, prior to plan approval, of the oversizing. After installation, actual cost data is required for oversizing payment.
- 7. The developer/customer shall submit "as-built" record drawings, prior to system acceptance, of the completed water main distribution system to Shakopee Public Utilities.
- 8. The Water Capacity Charge must be paid, prior to receiving service, in accordance with the Water Capacity Policy adopted by the Utilities Commission. The current rate is equal to \$5,693.00 per equivalent SAC unit, plus 13.4 cents per square foot for industrial use only, and is subject to change without notice.
